

## Times Tables Expectations

In the table below are the National Curriculum times tables end of year expectations for each year group.

We aim to provide opportunities for children to work regularly on their times tables in school, but it is important for them to practice regularly at home too.

Year 1	Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Recall and use doubles of all numbers to 10 and corresponding halves.
Year 2	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
Year 3	Recall and use the multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
Year 4	Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 x 12. (Statutory Multiplication Tables Check takes place in June)
Year 5	Revision of all multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12.
Year 6	Revision of all multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12.

### Ways to support your child in learning their times tables

- Display the times tables facts.
- Don't go too fast.
- Teach them some tricks e.g. using fingers for the 9 x table.
- Listen to them regularly or watch them e.g. Super Movers

- Play games with them e.g. using playing cards.
- Draw images or pictures to support them and help commit them to their long term memory.
- Quiz them regularly, but not incessantly.
- Reward their efforts – encouragement and praise go a long way.
- Try to make it fun!
